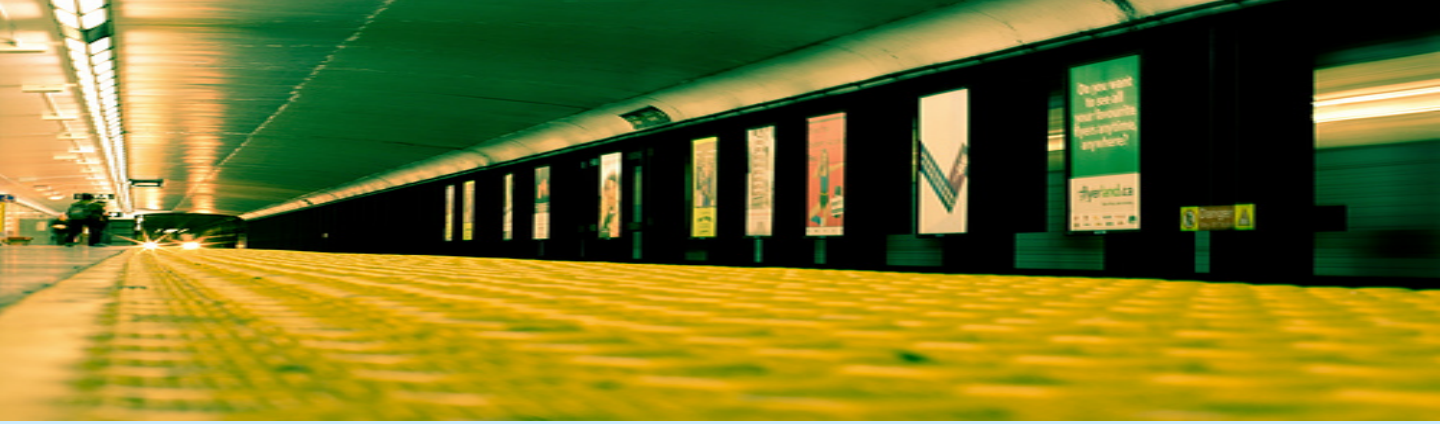

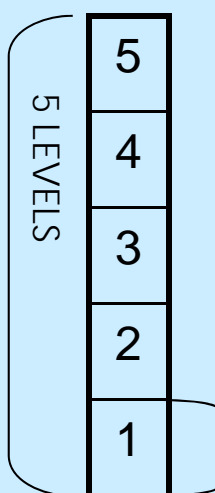

IELTS is a secure, valid and reliable test of real-life ability to communicate in English for education, immigration and professional accreditation.
