

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and University Placement

In accordance with the Curricular Guidelines of the Ontario Ministry of Education, graduation requirements are as follows;

- Earn a Total of 30 Credits
- Successful completion of the English Literacy Test and 40 Hours Community Service

In accordance with the Guidelines of Prestigious Universities in Canada, placement requirements are as follows.

- To take required Prerequisite Secondary School Courses
- Pass IELTS Examination
- High GPA from Secondary School

Therefore, Ontario International College is a Perfect pathway for admission to universities in Canada

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

Each Course is 1 Credit with a duration of 10 hours per a week per course

Students are required to take 7 credits per academic year



High School Credit Assesment and Study Plan are provided upon admission to the program.



Level 5: Advanced


Upon successful completion of each level, students will be awarded a certificate to recognize their achievement.

IELTS Preparation Program

What is IELTS?

IELTS is the International English Language Testing System.

IELTS conforms to the highest international standards of language assessment. It tests the four language skills – listening, reading, writing and speaking. IELTS is a secure, valid and reliable test of real-life ability to communicate in English for education, immigration and professional accreditation.

Our IELTS Prep Course

Our IELTS Preparation Program, consists of daily mock tests where the student can have a hands on practice approach in the following areas prior to the test:

- 1) Listening
- 2) Reading
- 3) Writing
- 4) Speaking
